In response to the new amended Order of governor DeWine, March 24, 2021, Antonine Village is amending its Visitation Policy as follows:

### **General guidance**

- One central point of entry to the facility
- All visitors must check at the front desk and be screened for COVID-19 symptoms, including symptoms assessment and questions about exposure to the virus.
- Babies and children under the age of 2 are now allowed.
- Visitors with any symptom or an exposure to the virus will not be permitted.
- A visitor with a history of COVID-19 is permitted to visit:
  - 14 days after diagnosis if visitor did not require hospitalization.
  - 20 days after diagnosis if visitor did require hospitalization.
- Visitors should inform the facility and cancel their visit in case they develop fever or experience any symptom for COVID-19.
- All visitors are to provide name and contact information on the log specified for visitors.
- Visitors are allowed for outdoor and indoor visitations, including the private single resident room, for all residents (regardless of vaccination status). Time frame for visits: **9 am to 11:45 am, 2 pm to 4:45 pm, and 6 pm to 8 pm.**
- Visitors are encouraged to be tested on their own prior to coming to the facility. They are also encouraged to be vaccinated, if feasible.
- Compassionate care visits are also allowed; they do not exclusively refer to end-of-life situations. They may include, but are not limited to:
  - A new resident struggling with change.
  - A resident who is grieving after a family member or a friend recently passed away.
  - A resident who needs encouragement with eating or drinking, previously provided by family and/or caregivers, and who is experiencing weight loss or dehydration.
  - A resident whose dementia has dramatically progressed.
  - A resident who has a new order for an anti-psychotic, and anti-depressant, or an appetite stimulant.
  - Anyone that can meet the resident's needs such as family members, clergy, or lay persons offering religious and spiritual support are permitted to participate in compassionate care visits.

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**Procedure:**

- Visitors are to call the main number of Antonine Village to schedule a visit at least two (2) days in advance.
- Two visitors ONLY are allowed at a time per each visit which can extend from 30 minutes to an hour.
- The main entrance of Antonine Village is the designated point of entry to the facility.
- The receptionist will screen all visitors for the presence of fever and symptoms consistent with COVID-19 and present visitors with screening and other identification information logs.
- Visitors are to facilitate social distancing anywhere during their visit, be able to wear a surgical/procedure mask which can be provided by Antonine Village, and not be a distraction to other residents, visitors, or staff.
- Hand sanitizers shall be made available to visitors and residents for use before, during, and after the visit.

**Religious services**

Residents may receive religious services from the religious leader of their choice at any reasonable time if it can be provided without disruption to care.
