Mustard & black Algae Treatment

Day ONE:

- 1. Broadcast Mustard treatment into Pool (dosage amounts on bottle)
- 2. Shock pool
- 3. Brush walls and steps and crevices of pool as much as possible

Day TWO:

- 1. Broadcast Mustard treatment into Pool (dosage amounts on bottle)
- 2. Shock pool
- 3. Brush walls and steps and crevices of pool as much as possible

Day THREE:

- 1. If algae is dead vacuum pool
- 2. Backwash pool and clean filter.

POINTS TO TAKE NOTE OF

- *This treatment will only effectively kill your mustard/black algae if:
- 1. at least two days of treatment are preformed consecutively
- 2. the two days of treatment are done within 24 hours of each other
- 3. the walls, steps, and crevices are brushed frequently and on a regular basis
- 4. the system if backwashed within 24 hours of last treatment.

FYI

*Mustard and Black algae are very prominent in the temperatures of 75 degrees and higher. They are also very tricky in the sense that your pool can be crystal clear one day and algae ridden the next day. This happens to do a chlorine loss in the pool. To prevent mustard and black algae it is very important to keep chlorine levels between 2 and 3ppm throughout the season. Keep in mind your pool will consume more chlorine in temperatures higher then 75 degrees. It is recommended that when we reach peak season during summer to always check your chlorine levels and double the dosage of chlorine if need be to keep the chlorine reading in range.

^{*}Sometimes another treatment is still needed and vacuuming, and backwashing will need to be pushed back another day.
