



URGENT ANNOUNCEMENT

LINDMORE IRRIGATION DISTRICT GROWERS

Water Availability: Since the last notice, the US Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) has made RWA and URF water available. Under these conditions, the Board will continue the “Wet Period” operation until further notice. Given the RWA and URF water available, all District landowners can take as much supply as they want from the District at a rate of \$80 an acre foot. After the Board declares the end of “Wet Period” Operations, they will set an allocation and a rate for that allocation.

Landowners are encouraged not to pump water from the ground. We estimate the availability of nearly 60,000 AF of water this year. Lindmore ID landowners’ annual crop water demand is approximately 62,000-65,000 AF a year. With 60,000 AF available, if landowners forgo pumping groundwater, this will greatly assist in groundwater aquifer recovery and recovery of depleted wells.

EKGSA: For EKGSA purposes, Lindmore ID is required to report all deliveries to landowner properties. Taking surface supply from Lindmore ID will therefore be added as a Surface Water Credit on your EKGSA Dashboard. Surface Water Credits remain on your Dashboard account in perpetuity or until used.

Line Operations and Outages: 5th Avenue line is nearly operational (Water Accounts beginning with a 3). We expect 5th Avenue line to be operational on April 3. All other lines are operational, with some intermittent outages due to leaks. The Board has approved contract work to assist staff in staying ahead of the leaks. Currently we are using Vollmer and Superior (two local firms with sufficient experience to do our line repairs).
