EASTER IS COMING

¹Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb. ²So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him." ⁸Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord"; and she told them that he had said these things to her. (John 20: 1-2, 8)

Easter is Coming! Knowing that Easter is coming is the hope and promise for all believers. During March confirmation class, I explained that this week, Holy Week, is central to the Christian faith. Without the crucifixion on Good Friday, there is no resurrection on Easter morning! I explained to the students that it is so important to their faith journey, that if they didn't attend Holy Week services, they are missing the journey to Jesus' ultimate act of love for them. I challenge you to the same! If you haven't attended Maundy Thursday and/or Good Friday worship services, attend this year! The Maundy Thursday Passover meal is part of the worship service. Sign up to reserve your place at the table. (The Seder meal, an orderly remembrance Passover meal, not a potluck dinner.) At the completion of the 45-minute meal, we will process into the sanctuary and hear Jesus' mandate for us, love one another as I have loved you. We will share Holy Communion and then strip the altar of all adornments. Good Friday service begins as Maundy Thursday ended: in silence. Good Friday service will remind us of Jesus' last seven words. We will receive nails from the same chalice that we drank from on Thursday. Those nails will be placed in the cross at the end of the service. The tomb is closed.

Then Easter is Coming! We gather to the cemetery on Sunday morning at 6:30 to discover that God has raised Jesus from the dead. Don't miss the completion of Jesus' journey to the cross during this Lenten season to the empty tomb on Easter morning! Festival worship service will be in the sanctuary at 9:00am.



Motion from the February Council meeting

March council actions:

The Support Team recommends that the damaged roof on the parsonage be repaired at a cost not to exceed \$1,000 with money to come from the Facility Use Fund. PASSED unanimously.



The Support Team recommends the removal of leaves at the Scout Hut that were raked from the cemetery. The cost to have all the leaves removed is \$350 with money to come from Undesignated Funds with the stipulation that the work can be done before April 7, 2023.

PASSED unanimously. Earl Sease will be asked to coordinate the work.






Sunday School for all ages.




