### College Bowl Issues Special Note:

**Please be aware that there will be no single bowl issue covering all 39 bowl games. This week's issue will only cover the bowl games played from December 26-29 (14 Bowls). Then the final bowl issue (sent Dec. 26) will cover the bowl games played from December 31-January 1 (11 bowls).**

Welcome to the 4th bowl edition of Powers' Picks. It is certainly a fun time of year to handicap games as you can find legit value in bowl games as long as you know what to look for. Like always, we don't characterize ourselves as strictly technical or situational handicappers. However, some of the things we look for in handicapping the bowl games are motivation factors. Is one team disappointed to be playing in this bowl (example: USC in the Sun Bowl a couple years ago) or is this team really excited to be playing in the bowl.

You also have to factor in the large schedule disparities in the games involving Power 5 conference teams against Group of 5 teams as many times a 6-6 SU Power 5 conference school is far superior to a 9-3/10-2 SU Group of 5 conference school. However, the Power 5 team played a much tougher schedule which skews their season stats but also gives you value this time of year.

Another thing to factor in when making your bowl selections is the travel distance to the bowl site for each school. While it doesn't necessarily affect the coaches and players so much, it does influence the fans as team's playing closer to home are likely to have the added crowd edge in what is supposed to be a neutral atmosphere.

Finally, you have to pay attention to the coaching situation. Not only are you dealing with interim coaches and a lot of coaching turnover, you also have to analyze how certain coaches do in bowl games. Some coaches are terrific regular season coaches but struggle in the bowl games for whatever reason.

We hope you enjoy this edition of the Powers' Picks and below are some answers to any possible questions you may have regarding this issue as it is different than the regular season editions.

### Bowl FAQ's

Why are you not doing one single bowl issue that covers all 39 games?

First, there are double the amount of bowl games as there were in the 1980's/90's and instead of all of them being played in one week (Christmas to New Year's Day), the bowls are spread out over the course of three weeks. Therefore, we're releasing our bowl picks in three separate issues. Those releases will only cover those particular bowl games being played that week (see left). Having later, more up-to-date information should result in more accurate results. We firmly believe you need to have later information in today's day and age!

How do I play your star-rated picks in the bowl issue(s)?

First, we will admit that most of the 1-star plays would not be included in a regular season issue. However, most of you will want action on every single bowl game for a variety of reasons and that is why we put a star-rated pick on every bowl game whether it is the side or the total. If you are someone that only likes to take part in a few games each week, then we would recommend you only play the 3-star and 4-star picks as they are clearly the strongest. If you are someone that likes to play 5-6 games a week, then the 2-stars are certainly worth your while.

Basically a 1-star rating during these bowl issues would be a lean (**these have gone 42-31-1 the last 3 years in bowl season so don't just overlook them**). A 2-star rating on a bowl is a strong lean while a 3-star or 4-star rating is your typical top star-rated play that you would see weekly in the regular season. Please note that the Powers' Pack selections are in rotation order.

#### Games in Rotation Order

##### Wednesday, December 26th

##### First Responder Bowl in Dallas, TX

1★ UNDER 56. † Boise State 27 Boston College 26. Both teams' prefer to run the ball on offense as Boston College ran 62% of the time this year while Boise St was especially run heavy down the stretch as their RB Alex Mattison had 77 carries for 400 yards in the final two games alone. However, both teams' strength on defense is stopping the run so there's a possibility of a stale-mate here. Note that Boise has seen the UNDER cash in each of their last 5 games while the UNDER has cashed in 4 of Boston College's last 5 games.

##### Quick Lane Bowl in Detroit, MI

2★ Georgia Tech (-5). † Georgia Tech 31 Minnesota 24. This will be the final game for Georgia Tech head coach Paul Johnson who is most likely heading to the CFB Hall of Fame thanks to 189 career wins at Ga Southern, Navy and here. On the other side, the Golden Gophers got into this bowl after pulling a big upset over Wisconsin in the season finale (Minn was +4 TO's). Minnesota does have 6 players suspended although those players' names haven't been released as of press time. They also saw LB Blake Cashman (leading tackler) and OT Donnell Greene skip out of this game to prepare for NFL draft. Johnson rides off into the sunset with his 4th bowl win and cover in his last 5.

##### Cheez-It Bowl in Phoenix, AZ

1★ OVER 39.5. † California 21 Tcu 20. We really struggled with the side on this one as TCU head coach Gary Patterson is coaching in his 17th bowl game while this is Cal head coach Justin Wilcox's first bowl. Also note that the Pac-12 is on a 2-14 ATS run in bowl games but TCU is down to a 3rd string QB. This is the lowest total on the board this bowl season. However, note that totals priced at 41 or lower went 31-22-2 to the OVER this season in Division I. Also while Cal was 9-3 to the UNDER this season, these two teams are a combined 15-9 to the OVER to this line.

##### Thursday December 27th

##### Independence Bowl in Shreveport, LA

2★ Duke (+4.5). † Temple 29 Duke 28. Maybe the biggest mis-match in coaching this bowl season as Duke head coach David Cutcliffe is 8-2 ATS in bowl games while Temple has an interim coach in Ed Foley. Foley was the interim coach two seasons ago when Temple lost outright to Wake Forest 34-26 as a 10.5-point favorite. We're certainly buying Duke low after a 59-7 loss to Wake Forest in the regular season finale (the worst loss in Cutcliffe's 17-year head coaching career). Temple's did struggle with good dual-threat QB's this year (Buffalo, UCF and Houston) and they face another here in Duke QB Daniel Jones. To the wire.

### **Pinstripe Bowl in Bronx, NY**

**1★ Wisconsin (+3.5).** † **Miami, FL 24 Wisconsin 22.** These two met in the Orange Bowl last year with Wisconsin winning 34-24 (-6). This will be the final game for Miami D.C. Manny Diaz who has taken the Temple HC job. Both teams had very disappointing seasons. Miami was actually favored in 11 games this year (won only 7) while Wisconsin was favored in 9 (won only 7). The main issue with both teams is QB play as Wisconsin QB's combined for 165 passing ypg (59%) and a 17-13 ratio while Miami QB's combined for 177 passing ypg (52%) with a 19-10 ratio. The Canes did win their final two games of the season while Wisconsin alternated wins/losses in their last 8 games. Wisconsin RB Taylor, the nation's leading rusher (1,989 rush yards) is the best player on the field. Finally, you trust Miami in the cold?

### **Texas Bowl in Houston, TX**

**1★ Baylor (+4).** † **Vanderbilt 29 Baylor 27.** Both teams should be excited to be here as the Bears got here with a win in the regular season finale as did the Commodores. Baylor was just 1-11 last year while Vanderbilt is trying to notch its first winning season since 2013 as the Dores covered each of their last 5 games. Baylor's leading receiver Jalen Hurd is out for this game. Obviously, Baylor should have the big crowd edge here playing in-state and that is our deciding factor here.

### **Friday, December 28th**

#### **Music City Bowl in Nashville, TN**

**1★ OVER 54.5.** † **Auburn 30 Purdue 27.** Auburn head coach Gus Malzahn is just 1-4 SU in bowls while Purdue head coach Jeff Brohm is 3-0 SU. Purdue should have the motivational edge here as Brohm decided to stay in West Lafayette after flirting with the Louisville job. Auburn QB Jarrett Stidham has declared early for the NFL Draft but will play in this game. He should have success vs a Purdue pass defense that ranks No. 123 in the country allowing 277 ypg. Meanwhile, Purdue QB Blough put up 300-plus passing yards in 8 of his last 10 games. We lean OVER.

#### **Camping World Bowl in Orlando, FL**

**3★ Syracuse (+1.5).** † **Syracuse 35 West Virginia 32.** We have a motivational mismatch here as West Virginia came up just short of making the Big 12 Title game while Syracuse hasn't played in a bowl since 2013 and is looking for their first 10-win season since 2001. The big story here is that WV QB Will Grier (37-8 ratio) has elected to skip this game and prep for the NFL Draft (WV's best OL is also skipping the game). Jack Allison will get the start but only attempted 10 passes this year. West Virginia head coach Dana Holgorsen has failed to cover in 5 straight bowl games and was angling for the Texas Tech job. We like the Orange outright and their fans have already sold out their allotment of tickets.

#### **Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, TX**

**2★ Iowa St (+3.5).** † **Washington St 28 Iowa St 27.** Washington St head coach Mike Leach is just 3-8 ATS as a bowl favorite and is just 1-7 ATS in his last 8 bowl games. Washington St's high-powered offense shouldn't scare the Cyclones' defense as they've already faced Top 20 offenses in Oklahoma, Okla St, West Virginia and Texas Tech and covered all 4 of those games while winning 3 of them outright. Washington St was thinking possible CFB Playoff berth until their arch rival Washington beat them in the regular season finale. Meanwhile, Iowa St is trying to win 9 games for the first time since 2000. To the wire.

### **Saturday, December 29th**

#### **Arizona Bowl in Tucson, AZ**

**2★ Nevada (+2).** † **Nevada 31 Arkansas St 30.** Had it not been for Nevada blowing a 23-0 lead to rival UNLV in the finale, the Wolf Pack would have entered this game with 5 straight wins. Meanwhile, Arkansas St did win 4 straight games to close the season but overall it was a disappointing season for Arkansas St who was a preseason division favorite in the Sun Belt. We think Nevada is more excited to be here as this is their first bowl game in the last 3 seasons and they are playing much closer to home. Meanwhile, Arkansas St has lost 3 of their last 4 bowl games.

### **Peach Bowl in Atlanta, GA**

**2★ Florida (+7.5).** † **Michigan 27 Florida 21.** Michigan is 4-0 SU vs the Gators including 3 bowl games and a 33-17 win in last year's season opener. We think Florida will have the motivational edge here as the Wolverines were thinking CFB Playoffs with 10 straight wins (by an average of 39-13) until their melt-down in Columbus. Despite allowing 567 yards to the Buckeyes, the Wolverines defense still ranks No. 1 in total D. While not in Michigan's class, UF's defense ranked solidly in the Top 30 this year and the Gators should be excited to be playing in a New Year's 6 bowl game after last year's 4-7 season. In a lower scoring game, we like taking the points here.

### **Belk Bowl in Charlotte, NC**

**1★ South Carolina (-5).** † **South Carolina 30 Virginia 24.** The Gamecocks will be without their big-play man on offense in WR Deebo Samuel who elected to skip the game and focus on the NFL Draft. Believe it or not, the only 2 QB's in CFB this year to top 2,400 yards passing and 800 yards rushing were the Heisman Trophy winner Kyler Murray and Virginia QB Bryce Perkins. Both teams are playing relatively close to home here but we expect SC to have the crowd edge. Slightest of picks here on the Gamecocks as we think the SEC has been far superior to the ACC this season and were 7-0 ATS in head-to-head match-ups during the regular season.

#### **Orange Bowl in Miami Gardens, FL (College Football Playoff Semi-final)**

**1★ Alabama (-14).** † **Alabama 47 Oklahoma 31.** These two last met in the Sugar Bowl after the 2013 season where Oklahoma pulled the big upset 45-31 (+16.5). Obviously, the Sooners have the nation's best offense averaging 578 ypg and 49.5 ppg (No. 1 in both categories) led by the Heisman Trophy winner in Kyler Murray who had 4,945 total yards and 51 total TD's. However, Alabama's offense wasn't far behind averaging 528 ypg and 48 ppg (No. 2 in scoring) this season led by the Heisman runner-up in Tua Tagovailoa who had 42 total TD's on 200 less snaps. The difference between these two teams is that Alabama also boasts a Top 10 defense allowing just 295 ypg and the Tide were No. 4 in scoring defense allowing 14.8 ppg. Meanwhile, the Sooners defense ranks No. 108 in total D (allowing 448 ypg) and were No. 96 in scoring D allowing 32.4 ppg. However, those numbers climbed to 43.2 ppg and 556 ypg in their last 5 games. This is the highest total ever for a team coached by Nick Saban. Oklahoma could be missing their deep threat in WR Marquise Brown (1,318 receiving yards) who was injured in the Big 12 Title game. That has us leaning with the Tide here.

#### **Cotton Bowl in Arlington, TX (College Football Playoff Semi-final)**

**1★ Notre Dame (+13.5).** † **Clemson 31 Notre Dame 20.** These two last played in that classic 2015 game where the Tigers won 24-22 (-2.5) in a driving rain storm. Both teams come in unbeaten as Clemson is making their 4th straight playoff appearance while ND is making their 1st. While Notre Dame has a rich history in the Cotton Bowl (5-2 SU with 4 wins over Top 6 teams), this is Clemson's first trip here since 1940. ND's offense surged in their final 9 games of the season after head coach Kelly switched to Ian Book at QB (70% completions, 19-6 ratio). It also coincided with the return of RB Williams who ran for 941 yards in the final 8 games. Meanwhile, Clemson also surged after they switched to true frosh Trevor Lawrence at QB in their final 9 games (65%, 24-4 ratio). The Tigers also have a big-play RB in Travis Etienne who ran for 1,463 (8.3 ypc) and 21 TD's. The big mismatch we believe will come in the trenches as Clemson's DL should over-power ND's OL that lost two Top 10 picks a year ago and haven't really been tested this season outside of the opener vs Michigan. However, we do think Clemson benefited from a weak ACC this year and when they stepped out of conference, that vaunted defense allowed 501 yards to Texas A&M and 600 yards to South Carolina. Look for Book to have some success down the field in the pass game and we also think ND will be playing with a chip on their shoulder as there is a lot of talk comparing this team to the 2012 team that was destroyed in the National Title game.

## **Week 17 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game**

For the past couple of seasons we have posted computer projected lines at pregame.com. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 155-129-7 (55%) clip the last two years.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping (much to our dismay). **So far this year's plays are 65-46-3.** Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

With 14 games on the schedule, there's 3 games this week where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), and that would be **Duke +4.5 over Temple, Nevada +2 over Arkansas St, and Notre Dame +13.5 over Clemson.** The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

#### Saturday, December 22nd

**TENNESSEE 23 Washington 14.** Last week we cashed on these pages with Tennessee as they shutout the Giants 17-0. That's now 3 straight wins for the Titans as RB Henry was the first Oiler/Titan player to top 150-yards rushing and 2 TD's in back-to-back weeks since Earl Campbell in 1980. Now they face a Washington team that found new life with a 4th string QB in Johnson last week in their upset over the Jaguars. Both teams need it bad to remain in the playoff hunt, but we're certainly not going to lay doubles with a low total.

**L.A. CHARGERS 26 Baltimore 20.** Last week the Chargers rallied from a 14-point 4Q deficit to upset the Chiefs in the final seconds (much to our dismay). It was the 2nd time they've accomplished that feat in the last 3 games (rallied from 16 down to PIT). Meanwhile, Baltimore comes in with a 4-1 record in their last 5 with QB Jackson under center. Do note that Baltimore faced some really poor rush defenses in those games and this will be by far his biggest test yet. Also the Chargers have extra rest off the Thursday game while Baltimore is traveling across country with one less day. Lean Chargers.

#### Sunday, December 23rd

**DALLAS 27 Tampa Bay 20.** Last week we easily cashed fading the Cowboys in their 23-0 loss at Indianapolis. It was the Cowboy's first shutout loss since 2003. We expect a better effort here as Dallas now needs this game after Philadelphia and Washington pulled big outright upsets last week. Meanwhile, Tampa Bay comes in off an 8-point loss at Baltimore and QB Winston has now lost his last 11 road starts. Also note Tampa Bay has allowed 100 or more rushing yards in 9 straight games (152 rush ypg, 5.3 ypc). That should have RB Elliott fantasy owners licking their chops.

**NEW ENGLAND 29 Buffalo 16.** New England has lost back-to-back games in December for the first time since 2002. To show these two teams' trend lines, note that New England was a 14-point favorite at Buffalo at the end of October and are now laying 12.5 at home. Obviously, Buffalo looks improved thanks to rookie QB Allen. While New England struggled on the road this season, they are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS at home. They also need the game badly if they want to have any chance at a 1st-round bye. Remember, the Pats have never made the Super Bowl in the Belichick era without a bye.

**Atlanta 23 CAROLINA 22.** After the loss to the Saints on MNF, we're not sure how much Carolina has left in the tank. The Panthers have now lost 6 straight games and QB Newton looks far less than 100%. Meanwhile, the Falcons got right in a blowout win over Arizona last week. If Newton ends up sitting this game, you have a bit of a free roll if you back the Falcons +2.5 right now.

**2★ MIAMI 23 Jacksonville 17.** Last week we easily cashed fading Miami in their blowout loss to Minnesota. However, now they come back home where they have won 9 straight when QB Tannehill is under center. They're facing a Jacksonville team that has nothing to play for after an embarrassing loss to Washington at home. They're now 1-9 SU/1-7-2 ATS in their last 10 games failing to cover the spread by 9 ppg. Miami needs this game to remain in the playoff hunt and unlike most playoff-need teams, we're not paying a big premium because of that blowout loss to the Vikings last week.

**INDIANAPOLIS 27 N.Y. Giants 19.** In each of the last two weeks, we have used Indianapolis as a 3★ on these pages and have come away with 2 easy winners. However, now we feel some value is gone with big point-spread. The Colts have won 7 of their last 8 but need to win their final 2 to still have a shot at the Wild Card. On the other side we also cashed fading the Giants last week in their shutout home loss to the Titans. However, the Giants have played much better on the road including 6 straight covers

**PHILADELPHIA 23 Houston 21.** The early money has come in on Philadelphia here as they have new life after their big upset win over the Rams last week as 13-point underdogs (biggest upset for Philly since 1985). Obviously, QB Foles is working his magic again with Wentz out. Meanwhile, the Texans got a fortunate cover vs the Jets last Saturday. Houston needs a win in their final two games to lock up the No. 2 seed in the AFC. However, troubling is that they have allowed 52 sacks this year (worst mark in the NFL).

**2★ Minnesota 24 DETROIT 16.** After last week's blowout win over the Dolphins where we easily cashed on a 2★ on these pages, we're going right back to the well here with the Vikings. A part of their success last week came with the new O.C. Kevin Stefanski as they re-dedicated themselves to the run game (season-high 40 rush attempts). They also had a NFL season-high 202 total yards in the 1Q and had 9 sacks on defense. Remember in the earlier meeting, the Vikings sacked Stafford 10 times. Now Detroit is more beat up than that earlier meeting and the offense has manged just 16 ppg in their last 7 games.

**N.Y. JETS 23 Green Bay 21.** With this line at "Pick-Em", it looks like Green Bay QB Aaron Rodgers is a 50/50 proposition to play here. After last week's loss in Chicago, the Packers are now on a 0-9 SU/1-7-1 ATS run on the road and have clinched a losing season. Meanwhile, the Jets showed some fight in a loss to Houston last Saturday. With this projected score, we're again "free rolling" with the Jets here as they would be favored by a FG or so if backup DeShone Kizer ends up starting for the Pack.

**CLEVELAND 26 Cincinnati 18.** After last week's win in Denver that ended the longest series losing streak in the NFL at 11 games (first win over Broncos since 1990), the Browns are now in their largest favorite role since 2010. Meanwhile, the Bengals broke their 5-game losing streak with a win over the hapless Raiders. Three weeks ago, the Browns hammered the Bengals 35-20 in Cincy in a game that wasn't as close as the final. Despite having a very small chance at the playoffs, we expect the Browns to be max motivated here. The problem is that it's certainly being priced into the line.

**L.A. Rams 29 ARIZONA 16.** The Rams since their hot 3-0 SU/ATS start, are just 2-7-2 ATS and last week lost outright as 13-point favorites to the Eagles. You can pretty much forget the No. 1 seed now as the Rams need the Saints to lose both of their final two games. RB Gurley looks like he is banged up and QB Goff has just a 1-7 ratio in his last 3 games. However, can you trust a Arizona team that was crushed at Atlanta last week. They've lost their last 3 games vs the Rams by a combined 99-16!

**Chicago 22 SAN FRANCISCO 21.** After back-to-back home wins over the Broncos and Seahawks, the 49ers are now 7-1 SU in the month of December under head coach Shanahan. That says a lot considering the 49ers were out of playoff contention each year. This is a flat spot for Chicago off home wins against the Rams and Packers having clinched their first playoff berth since 2010. The Bears have already lost outright on the road as favorites to Miami and the Giants and we think this one also goes down to the wire.

**NEW ORLEANS 29 Pittsburgh 24.** The Steelers may have saved their season last week with an upset win over the Patriots. They found their running game again thanks to RB Samuels (142 rushing yards). However, he might find it tough sledding against a New Orleans rush D that ranks No. 1 in the NFL. Meanwhile, the Saints offense has been struggling the last 4 games averaging only 20 ppg. However, New Orleans' defense has risen to the occasion and in fact are the No. 1 scoring defense in the NFL in the last 6 weeks allowing just 12 ppg. A win here for the Saints and they clinch homefield advantage.

**3★ SEATTLE 27 Kansas City 26.** Are the Chiefs still feeling sorry for themselves after blowing a 14-point 4Q lead last week vs the Chargers? KC now is on a 0-4-1 ATS run and are dealing with a banged-up skill position group. They also need to win continue with the Chargers breathing down their necks in the division. Meanwhile, Seattle was on a 4-0-1 ATS run and had won 4 straight games prior to losing in OT to San Francisco last week. QB Wilson still has a 13-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 6 games. If you flipped home field in this one (awarded 3 points of HFA to each team), would you be comfortable laying 8.5 with KC? We certainly wouldn't. Also note that since January 2011, the Seahawks are 11-1-1 ATS as a home dog with 9 outright wins.

#### Monday, December 24th

**Denver 22 OAKLAND 21.** The final Monday Night game of the season is a dud just like this year's ESPN MNF announce team. Oakland HC Gruden used to be on that announce team but now he's collecting even bigger checks from an Oakland organization that is in complete rebuild. Oakland should be fired up for the prime-time slot also knowing they should've beat Denver in the first meeting (blew a 12-0 lead). The Broncos suffered a bubble-bursting loss to the 49ers a couple weeks ago and again lost last week to the Browns.
