### Laudato Si' (2015)

In *Laudato Si' – On Care for our Common Home*, Pope Francis urges society to move away from the myth of constant, relentless progress, at the expense of the earth's resources. Instead, Pope Francis says we need to recognize that 'everything is connected' and we must hear both 'the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor.' *Laudato Si'* calls for all people to exchange ideas about how best to tackle the global issues we face.



### Laudate Deum (2023)

Pope Francis states that the title of this follow up letter is "Praise God" because "when human beings claim to take God's place, they become their own worst enemies." By this he means that the more we seek to increase power for its own sake, the less we use our power to protect life. Power should be used to create a better world for all and *Laudate Deum* is an urgent plea for us all to take action before it is too late.

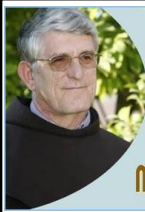

## WORLD MISSION SUNDAY OCTOBER 22nd



At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The collection this Sunday is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will continue to be used until 2020 to assist six dioceses in Northern Canada which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation. Pastors and pastoral workers are invited to encourage among all the people of God a missionary spirit, to promote missionary vocations, and to collaborate spiritually and materially in the Church's mission work, including support for all the dioceses in our country's northern regions.
