Test of Choice – Walk/Walk; Introductory A, B, C, D; Basic A, B, C, D; Level 1 A, B, C, D:

Six Divisions – can only choose one - PeeWee (under 12 years), Junior (12-18 years), Adult Amateur, Senior Amateur (50+ years), Pro and Gaited

Class fees - \$20 per test

Office fee - \$10 per horse & rider combination

Non-Member fee - \$15

General Information:

1. Must be SMWSD member or pay non-member fee. If you wish scores to be sent to WSDAC for National Points, must be WSDAC member and have Horse registration. SMWSD member scores will count towards club Year End Awards.
2. Walk/Wlk, Introductory and Basic tests must be ridden in 20mx40m ring, Level 1 & 2 tests ridden in 20mx60m ring. Use arenas that are as near as possible to regulation size and be sure letters are set appropriately to be viewed by the judge. **Helmets STRONGLY recommended for all, mandatory for juniors.**
3. Strip ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.
4. Entries to be submitted online. If you do not have access to a scanner send all information in an email and we will fill out form for you. Payment by e-transfer or cheque. Entry will be considered complete and tests assigned to judge only after completed entry form and payment received.
5. Judge will send photos of scored test to your cell phone.

Video Information:

1. Videos must be uploaded to your own YouTube account then link sent to show secretary, only one video per test; **two judges may not judge the same test**
2. Full video instructions to be found at www.westernstyledressage.ca Rulebook, 16.04, pages 53-55. **Please read them over.**
3. Tests must be videoed from C in the horizontal landscape orientation.
4. Videos of tests must be **UNEDITED** from start to finish. They must be **one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.** Make sure test ring letters are in the frame, may zoom in slightly in the far corners, pay close attention to near corners.
5. Tests may be called. **Sound must be on**, natural background noise audible.
6. Prior to test ride beginning a **class information sign** must be held up showing the name of the show, the date of the show, the horse's name and test being ridden
7. At the end of the ride **tack check** either the camera must slowly circle the horse & rider or the rider may show one side of horse at G (5 sec), slowly turn to show second side (5 sec)
