## **Interest Group Happenings**

#### **Secret Sisters**

Are you interested in joining Secret Sisters?

WE ARE MIXING THINGS UP THIS YEAR, SO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

Here are the details: Each Secret Sister will complete a questionnaire about herself (available on the MFF website and via email). The deadline to confirm your commitment and submit your **completed questionnaire** is **Sunday, September 22**. Whoever gets assigned to be your Secret Sister for the club year may use the information provided in your questionnaire to pick out some special gifts for you! This is where things get a little funky...

We will have our first (1) of three (3) **Gift Exchange Potluck** Parties on **Thursday, October 10**. The catch: You should bring a gift suitable for ANYONE, as we will <u>not</u> know the Secret Sister assignments at this point. After dinner, we will accomplish the following:

- **1. Select our Secret Sisters RANDOMLY:** There will be no formal assignments this year in an effort to spice things up a bit!
- 2. Select our "Delivery People:" Once we've all established, secretly, who we'll be giving gifts to for the club year, we'll then do a second random drawing to pick a friend who will help you deliver those gifts! This person will be there for you if you need assistance with your monthly deliveries to help you keep your anonymity. This way no one will accidently catch their ACTUAL Secret Sister on their home surveillance camera, ruining the surprise!
- 3. Have a Yankee Swap-style gift exchange. So, make sure whatever gift you bring to this first party is something you wouldn't mind going home with because, who knows, you might!

Everything else will remain the same. You will provide a gift each month between October-June.

- Three of those months, gifts will be exchanged at our Potluck parties October, January, and May (with October being a Yankee Swap gift). Evite will provide more details.
- You may rely on the help of your "Delivery Person" to deliver your gifts to your Secret Sister the other months – November, December, February, March, and April.
- In June, you will give a "thank you" gift to the not-so-secret-anymore Sister who had been giving gifts to YOU for the previous eight months!

The value should be kept around \$15-20 for your monthly gift. And we ask that no one "double dip" and buy one large, more expensive gift to count for multiple months. If you've never participated before, it may sound confusing, but don't worry – we'll review the process and "what if" scenarios at the first potluck so that no one feels overwhelmed.



We would love to have you in this group, but also want to make mention that unlike our other interest groups, this is a commitment for the entire club year. We ask that once you join us, you understand that a very special woman (your Secret Sister) is counting on your full participation. There is no fee to join Secret Sisters. However, we ask that you pay your annual membership dues to the club before participating.

If you have any questions or need more information, feel free to contact Jill Mitchell! You can either email your completed questionnaire or print it and hand-deliver or snail-mail it to Jill. Regardless, we recommend saving a completed copy to your computer so that you have it handy for next year. Trust us, you'll have so much fun you'll want to join the group again!
