Salute to the Flag / Regular meeting call to order:

Public Participation:

As Discussed:

<u>Doug and Tina Stauski</u>- Complained of the livestock running at large on their property, inadequate livestock fencing and their feces on their property. Loud motorcross bikes and or three wheelers racing around on the adjoining residential parcel. Washington Township does have a Nuisance Ordinance; the township does not own a meter to measure decibels. Solicitor advises the homeowners to contact an Attorney, or filing a criminal complaint with the local Magistrates Office. State Police have been contacted.

John Lingafelt-selling a parcel of property, the adjoining land owner stated that a section of the garage previous built in the 1940's is approximately 8" to 10" on his property. Solicitor suggests a minor adjustment to the preliminary plan or a permanent right of way or easement. Current adjoining property owner is not in favor of a right-of way or easement. Minor Adjustments to current lot line without creating a new lot. New plan with a minor boundary line adjustment will need to be forwarded to the township for approval.

<u>Tony Zumer</u>- Concerns with the parking lot for the Lilly –Washington War Memorial Park and the Miners Memorial Monument, there is not line denoting the difference between the parking lot and Memorial Drive. The Supervisors understand Mr. Zumer's concerns; all road and parking lot surfaces are in Borough of Lilly.

<u>Todd Beiswenger-</u> representing Young Engineers with concern to the Fabbri/Savino properties and the requested subdivision for a side lot addition as the property can be served by potable water by Highland Water and Sewer Authority. Highland will not cross anyone else property in order to connect a single residential water service. Side lot addition will rectify to problem.

Motion made by Raymond Guzic, Jr 2nd Scott Guzic to approved the Side Lot Addition Plan, subject to approval of the Cambria County Planning Commission. Roll Call, All in Favor Motion Passed.

Raymond Guzic Jr.-Guzic Lane is now a private lane, Washington Township to take ownership of Guzic Lane, Cal-de-sac and set backs have been previously recorded under an older subdivision. TABLED item until Deed of Dedication has been completed.
