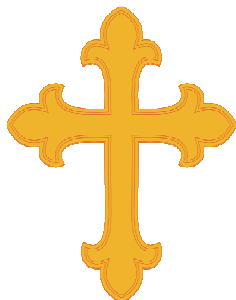

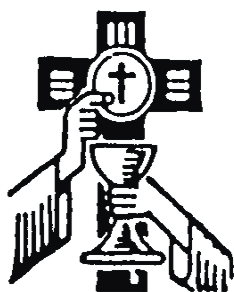

A Father's Simple Sermon

I distinctly recall the day when my faith took firm root. I was 7 years old and my sisters and I had just been summoned by my dad to join him around the kitchen table while my mom fixed him dinner. It was late, around 10 p.m. Dad had been out with his buddies. Sometimes when he came home late he'd have a pack of White Castle sliders to share with us, but this night he just wanted to talk.

"Girls, he said, 'I know you're excited about Christmas, but I want to make sure you understand what it all means. I've been thinking about this a lot, and I just want to make sure you get it.

"God chose to come to earth as a baby—a tiny newborn baby—not a king, not some mighty warrior who would force us to do his will. No, he chose to come to us as a helpless, needy babe, swaddled and cuddled by his mother and watched over by his father.

"Just think about what that says about who God is: God is a God of love and peace; of tenderness and care. That's the God we believe in. That's the God you want to follow."

And thus my father, like Jesus, spoke in words we could understand, scattered the seeds of faith, and watched it grow in his children. Thanks, Dad, for the most memorable sermon on the Incarnation I've ever heard.
