

Long term Master Plan for Lake front Restoration:

- We Continue to Develop a long-term master plan for future lake shore restoration prioritizing work on the next most critical areas: Due to concerns with budget issues, including uncertainty of costs of Clubhouse Repair, future Lake front restoration projects have been temporarily put on hold. Initiatives of Long Term Lake front Erosion Control:

- *"Adopt a Shoreline" program, where homeowners and generous individuals or groups can participate in sponsoring and/or participating in future shoreline restoration efforts and be recognized for their contributions and efforts*
- *Evaluate feasibility of establishing a combination of hard armouring and native shoreline buffers to*
 1. *protect our shoreline from further erosion,*
 2. *buffer watershed run-off into our lake,*
 3. *help deter geese from nesting, loitering and soiling our lake front common areas.*
 4. *improve aesthetic appearance of our lake front.*
