TODAY'S "QUICK HIT": CHECK YOUR FACTS AND ASSERTIONS! PLEASE!

Here's what provoked me:

A well-intended letter writer fell into the trap of using unsubstantiated "internet traffic" as a basis to scold an earlier writer. It involved an important topic regarding police, guns, BLM, and interracial crime. Such a topic deserves some attention to details and accurate information.

Here's my response:

Check Your Facts and Assertions! Please!

On September 16 Marlon Micou presented an unhelpful "scold" ("Black lives"). The "scoldee" is Craig Cohea who had a letter published on August 7 ("UNI graffiti"). Micou claims inaccuracy in Cohea's facts and offers his own version.
