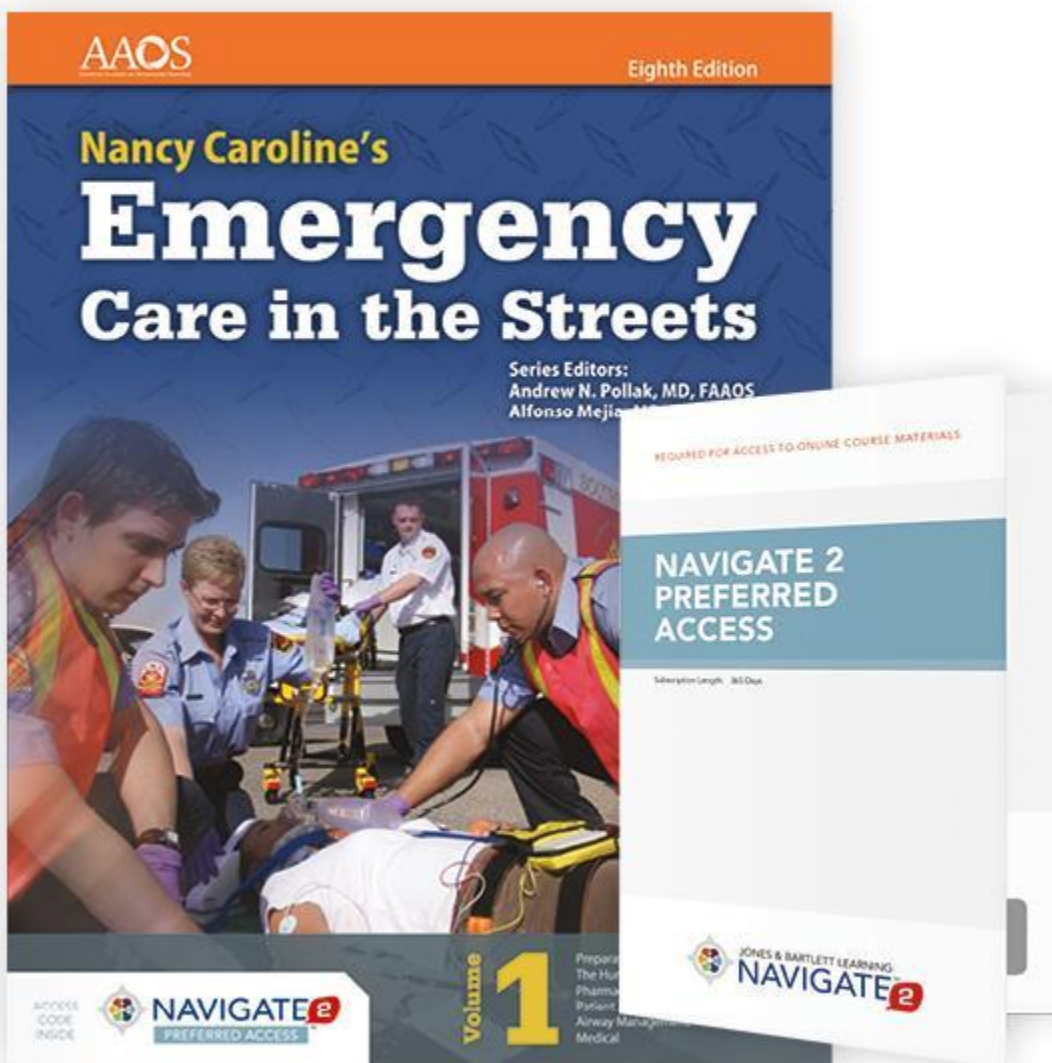

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

The Paramedic student must complete the following to be considered for graduation. These requirements must be completed prior to taking the final exam

1. Complete all required class, lab and clinical hours.
2. Pass each module exam, mid-term and final with 80% or above
3. Complete ACLS, PALS, ITLS courses.

These courses shall be held during the course and shall be conducted at EMETSEEI Institute.

4. Demonstrate competencies in required critical tasks as outlined in skills lab, clinical and field internships.

5. Meets all financial requirements.
