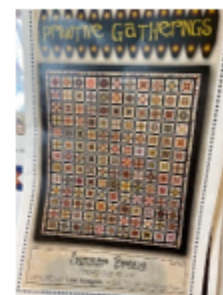


as well as Yuletide Gatherings flannel by Primitive Gatherings. We also have several copies of all the new book
