<u>August 3, 2017</u> TBLA Monthly Social Dinner SCOA Toledo Town 7:00 p.m. <u>Annual TBLA/SWCD Youth Fish Fest was held June 3rd</u> – The 8th Annual Toledo Bend Lake Association /Sabine Soil and Water Conservation District Youth Fish Fest was held June 3, 2017, at Cypress Bend Park and <u>It Was All About Young</u> <u>Anglers</u>. On Saturday, June 3, 2017, it was easy to spot these young anglers on the Park piers, lake banks, and even the beach at the Eighth Annual TBLA/Sabine SWCD Fish Fest.



Pre-registered anglers enjoyed a free day of fishing at Cypress Bend Park. The Fest was open to school-age children in kindergarten through 12th grades for the school year 2016-2017. Youth from Louisiana and Texas were eligible to fish. Anglers who catch one of the largest three fish in the categories of bass, bream, catfish, white perch (crappie), turtle, and other win a rod and reel combo and a medal. Anglers provided their own fishing equipment and bait. All anglers checked in at the registration table to pick up a TBLA/Sabine SWCD turquoise Fish Fest t-shirt which had to be worn during the tournament and receive their SRA bright blue ditty bags full of cups, pencils, pens, Mardi Gras beads, wacky suckers, visors, sun shades, and plastic baits. Fishing began at 7:30 a.m. and hopeful anglers had to be in the weigh-in line by 11:00 a.m.

While bank fishing, 110 youth anglers certainly face challenges, but the smiles on their faces and the thought of winning a new rod and reel combo outweighed the obstacles. Fifty three of the competitors weighed in 8 bass, 11 catfish, 18 turtles, 5 other fish including freshwater drum and shad. Large stringers of bream were caught, but anglers were only allowed to weigh in their largest catch in each category. No crappies were weighed in.



Emcee, Mr. Chris Pearce, of the Sabine SWCD opened the awards ceremony by thanking the TBLA, numerous sponsors, volunteers, and Fish Fest coordinators Mrs. Becky Anderson, SRA and Mrs. Anita Manshack, SWCD. Mrs. Gaynell Goodeaux, TBLA Treasurer addressed the crowd, thanked them for attending, bringing their children, and invited interested individuals to join the TBLA. John Toliver, TBLA Past President, served as the tournament photographer.

All division winners $(1^{st} - 3^{rd})$ received an engraved medal, a rod and reel combo, and their name in the record book. Door prizes included rod and reel combos, tackle boxes, caps, spot lights, swim noodles, pocket knives, gift certificates, beach bags, water bottles, inflatable beach balls and rafts, cricket cages, and other fishing tackle. There were enough door prizes donated to provide one for every angler.

There is no doubt that every parent, grandparent, and volunteer enjoyed watching our young anglers have a great fishing day on beautiful Toledo Bend Lake.
