Rules

Rule 18-2b

Withdrawal of Rule on Ball Moving After Address

This Rule assessed a one-stroke penalty if a ball at rest moved after it was addressed. Now a one-stroke penalty will be applied only when the facts show that the player has caused the ball to move.

The wind in Laughlin reminded me of another of the rule changes for 2016. If you have

ever had the wind move your ball on the putting green, you were probably asked "Did you ground the club or where you hovering the putter head?" because if you addressed the ball, and the wind moved it, you were penalized. Well, the R&A and USGA have finally agreed that we golfers don't control the wind. With the rule change, you are only penalized if you caused the ball to move.
