

European Commission publishes another set of Q&A's on the upcoming VAT changes

(July 1, 2014)

As per January 1, 2015 the VAT rules regarding telecommunications/broadcasting/electronic services provided to consumers will change. As of that date the place of supply will be the member state of the consumer. Today the European Commission published another set of Q&A's on the upcoming VAT changes. The questions discussed are: Why was this change in VAT rules needed, what type of transactions will be covered, what has the commission done to prepare, what have Member States done to prepare, what do businesses need to do to prepare, how can compliance be ensured, will this mean a rise in prices for these services in most Member States, will this mean a loss in revenue for certain Member States where a large number of e-service providers are resident, shouldn't the One Stop Shop concept be extended to all e-commerce supplies (incl distance sales)?
