## **VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT 1 BECAUSE IT:**

- X Gives tax breaks to owners of more expensive homes, making our property tax system more complicated and less fair.
- X Most homeowners, renters and small businesses will pick up the tab for an additional tax break that benefits a select group of homeowners.
- X The Florida Association of Counties estimates the measure would cost local governments \$687.5 million annually, leading to higher taxes or cuts to services.
- X Gives Tallahassee politicians control over how we pay for essential community services like public safety.

We shouldn't be giving special tax breaks to big corporations while we're spending less on public education, barely covering basic services for senior citizens and allowing millions of Floridians to go without health care.

## **VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT 5 BECAUSE IT:**

- X Locks in special tax breaks for the wealthy and well-connected, at the expense of everyone else.
- X Allows a handful of bought-and-paid-for politicians to block any attempts to end the special tax breaks for big corporations.
- X Makes it nearly impossible to cover the growing cost of emergency services, environmental disasters and hurricane clean-up.
- X Puts Florida on a dangerous path alongside other states that have enacted similar laws, leading to budget shutdowns, cuts in state services and teacher strikes.
