Lodging - Out of town participants housed at The Iberville Suites located at 910 Iberville Street, New Orleans, LA 70112. The Iberville Suites is located in the New Orleans Historic French Quarter. Mileage – Summer Institute attendees who travel over 100 miles round trip will be eligible for a scheduled mileage reimbursement. Mileage Reimbursement Schedule:
100-200 miles - \$40, 200-300 miles - \$60, 300-400 miles - \$80, 400-500 miles - \$100, 500-600 miles - \$120

We the People Textbooks - Teachers who have completed the Summer Institute are eligible to receive one set of thirty *We the People* textbooks and one teacher's guide, all of which will be delivered to the teacher's school.
