Norma A. Annis, 96, of Grand Marais, Minn., passed away Saturday, May, 27, 2000 in Hill Haven Homes Plus in Grand Marais following a long illness. Born in Oscoda on Aug. 6, 1903, she was the daughter of the late Ernest and Anna (Becker) LeBahn.
