Smokin' up the Saddle Club Rules & Regulations

PRODUCT

1. Exhibitors may only show and sell work from the category in which they have been accepted. Any items of work not listed in the application, and/or not created by the exhibitor must be removed from the show. Management will prohibit the installation and operation of any exhibits not meeting its approval.
2. All articles and displays must be in good taste with no reference to race, ethnic, gender, sexual, or religious prejudice. No obscene items will be allowed.

BOOTH DISPLAY & SET-UP

1. Exhibitors must furnish their own display tables, skirting, chairs, extension cords, tents, etc. All displays must be designed, constructed and operated in good taste.
2. All displays, transactions, signage, and activities must be confined to exhibitor's assigned space. Signs, tents, canopies or any other part or display may not extend over or into walkways.
3. Booths may not be sublet or shared with another exhibitor or artist.
4. All booths must be set up and manned by 8:30a.m. on the morning of the festival.
5. All vehicles must be removed from the grounds by 8:00a.m. NO vehicles are allowed on the fairgrounds during show hours. All vehicles should be parked in designated vendor parking.
6. Only official Smokin' up the Saddle Club motorized carts and emergency vehicles will be allowed within the fairgrounds during show hours.
7. If you have to restock from your trailer or vehicle during festival hours, please be prepared to do so yourself with a dolly.
8. No booths will be allowed to breakdown prior to the close of the festival which will be at 6:00p.m. on Saturday.
9. Set-up will be Friday, November 13th, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and on Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday evenings with the understanding that the Smokin up the Saddle Club Board & it's affiliates is not, and will not be responsible in any way for loss or damage to participant's property. Exhibitors are responsible for their personal and property liability.
10. Overnight camping for vendors will be allowed within the fenced festival grounds but limited spots will be available for a fee of \$30/night.

ADDITIONAL FESTIVAL RULES

1. NO ANIMALS (including pets) are allowed on the fairgrounds with the exception of identifiable service dogs.
2. No political rallies, speeches, campaign hand bills or political solicitations of any kind are allowed on the fairgrounds, both inside and outside the fenced areas.
3. Gas powered generators are strictly prohibited.
4. Electricity is a paid amenity and is limited to those who specifically need it to demonstrate their craft, food production or other necessary functions.
