INTERLAKE BYLAW 2023-01 INTERLAKE REGIONAL WATER BOARD **UTILITY RATES BYLAW**

A BYLAW OF THE INTERLAKE REGIONAL WATER BOARD TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF REVERSE OSMOSIS WATER AND THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE INFRASTRUCTURE.

The Board of the Interlake Regional Water Utility Board, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "Utility Rates Bylaw".
- 2. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Interlake Rates Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the connection fee shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
- 3. Accounts for water service shall cover a period of three consecutive months, and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, the water service may be shut off. When the water service is shut off, it shall not be turned on until all arrears have been paid, together with the re-connect fees set out in Interlake Rates Schedule "A" attached, to cover expenses of turning off the water and turning it on again.
- 4. A late payment interest charge as set out in Interlake Rates Schedule "A" shall be added to all water accounts remaining outstanding thirty days after the quarterly billing date and shall be compounded monthly thereafter, to the amount in arrears. Accounts that remain in arrears for a period of 30 days or more may be subject to collection by authority under The Municipalities Act.

- 5. The bulk reverse osmosis water rate as set out in Interlake Rates
 Schedule "A" attached shall be charged only to persons obtaining reverse
 osmosis water from the bulk distribution supply meter at the Interlake
 Water Treatment Plant.
- Bylaw No 2/2020 adopted by resolution of Council on the 22nd day of October, 2020 is hereby repealed.
- 7. The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee or January 1, 2024. Whichever is the later.

- c) Yearly Subscribers Infrastructure Levy \$200 billed quarterly (\$50 per quarter).

2) New Subscribers Rates:

- a) Resort Village of Cochin including a (T10 R9001) ¾" meter \$6000.
- b) RM of Meota including (T10 R9001) 3/4" meter \$6000.

NOTE: Does not include costs of a plumbing permit, materials and labor required for installation of a new connection. All new connections must be installed by a professional contractor approved by Interlake.

3) Campgrounds or Trailer/RV Parking:

a) Shall pay \$200 per Trailer/RV per year in lieu of the base rate of a regular user.
