At Pomperaug High School, four scholarships were awarded last June.

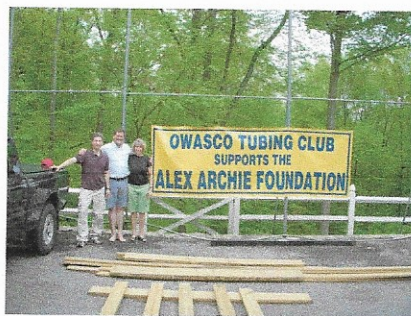

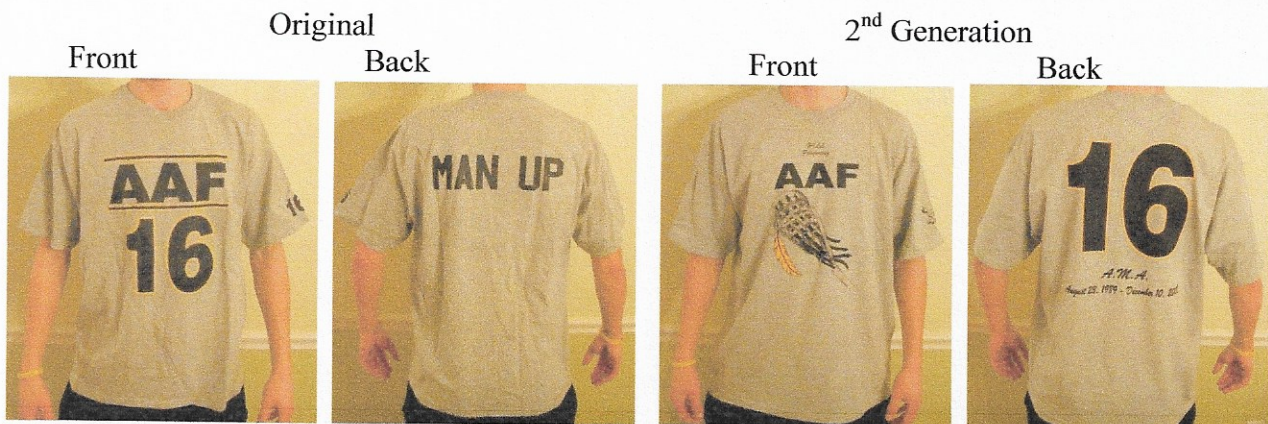


Head Boys Lacrosse coach, Mark DePietro, chose one player from the team, co-captain Ian Suter who is a student at Endicott College. Congratulations to all!
