PLANNING COMMISSION AGENDA INCLUDES – A hearing to consider a permit for a wireless facility at 790 Moss Lane approximately 1.5 miles outside of Templeton; a request for a permit to establish a cannabis nursery with up to 3 acres of outdoor (hoop house) cultivation, up to 22,000 square feet of indoor greenhouse cultivation, and up to 28,210 square feet of commercial cannabis nursery, with a dispensary and processing facilities located at 13350 River Road one mile outside of San Miguel; consideration of a permit to establish 21,600 square feet of indoor mixed-light cannabis cultivation with five greenhouses, 3,643 square feet of indoor nursery with one greenhouse, seven cargo containers for material storage, and related items at 457 Green Gate Road outside of SLO; and a hearing to consider a request by Pacific Gas & Electricity for the North Ranch Road Improvement Project.
