*Step-up program students begin in August going MWF, step-up to MTWF Oct. 1st and begin M-F January 2nd.

Registration:

Immunization records and birth certificates are required for all students. These documents need to be on file within 30 days after your child begins a program.

Children must be 3 years old by August 1st and potty trained to enroll in the three/four preschool class.

No child will be refused enrollment on the basis of sex, color, religion, ethnic background, handicap, or origin.

Special needs concerns must be discussed with Mrs. Howard and Mrs. Rentschler prior to registration. We will not admit any child whose educational needs we cannot obviously meet.

No child will remain in the preschool program whose behavior threatens the safety of the other children enrolled in the preschool program.

Enrollment is based on a first come basis as space permits.

We are sorry, but there is no reduction in monthly tuition for absenteeism or vacations. Each family will have 10 equal payments from August-May.

Each family will receive a monthly tuition notice based on the enrollment of each child. Invoices will be emailed. **Tuition is due by the 1st of each month.** Payments can be made online via bank draft. Cash and checks are also accepted at LSA. **A \$10 late fee will be issued for any payment not received by the 1st.** Any payments past 30 days or more will result in the dismissal of your child.

Also a \$10 fee is charged when the program receives a non-sufficient fund check. After two NSF checks tuition must be paid in cash. Checks will not be accepted as payment.

Please note the class and number of days you sign up for is the class and number of days your child will stay in the whole year unless previous arrangements have

been made with the teacher. Due to a limited amount of spots we can not change your student's schedule.

Un-enrollment

If for some reason you need to un-enroll your child from Little Scholars please let us know one month prior to the month you want your child to stop coming.

Extended Vacations

If you are planning on a vacation that will last a month or more you will need to continue to pay tuition or un-enroll your child. When you return from your vacation you are welcome to reenroll your child if the spot is still available.

School Calendar/Inclement Weather:

The preschool programs will start on August 15th and run through May 16th. In case of inclement weather, we will follow the lead taken by South Harrison School Corporation. If there is a 2 hour delay, all morning sessions at LSA will be cancelled. **WE WILL NOT MAKE UP TWO HOUR DELAYS.** Afternoon classes will proceed with classes on these days. We guarantee 167 days out of our 177 days. If we need to make up any more to reach our 167 days we will add days after May 16th.

Goals and Objectives:

- * To provide a nurturing child-centered learning environment
- * To assist the social, emotional, physical, and intellectual growth of the preschool child
- * To provide positive group and individual interactions with children and adults
- * To foster a love of learning
- * To encourage the individual talents of each preschool child
- * To encourage sharing and cooperation
- * To develop individuality

Snack Policy:

Healthy snacks boost energy and help children regain focus. Students in both sessions will have snack time. Please send a healthy snack and drink with your child in their backpack.

Birthday Party Policy:

Your child may bring in a special treat to share with friends to celebrate his/her birthday. Please make arrangements with your child's teacher prior to your child's birthday.

Sick Child Policy:

If your child has a fever over 100 degrees F, has a persistent cough or runny nose that is not clear, or has diarrhea or vomiting we ask that you please keep your child at home for at least 24 hours for the health and safety of the other children and staff. We also ask that if your child was given an antibiotic please allow 24 hours before returning to school.

Lice

If your child has lice we will ask that your child be picked up from school. Your child can return after he or she is properly treated. The child will be checked, when he or she returns to school, to make sure there are no lice and/or nits. They will not be able to stay at school with lice and/or nits.

Program Details

3/4 Preschool Class

Your child will participate in *Mother Goose Time* curriculum. *Mother Goose Time* is a professionally designed preschool curriculum that nurtures the whole child and supports the child's social, emotional and intellectual growth. Children are encouraged to choose activities during learning center time and to actively participate in music, story, and circle time which are brief teacher-led group activities. Blocks, math and reading manipulative, books, art, dress up, and cooking are just a few activities available to your preschooler daily. We believe your child needs both structured and unstructured types of play to maximize learning and social development. We strive to provide a quality play-based, student-centered learning environment in which every student can grow and develop successfully at an individual pace.

4/5 Kindergarten Prep Class

Your child will participate in the Funshine Express: Fireflies curriculum. Fireflies is a high-quality, professionally-designed early learning program that creates enthusiasm for learning and builds school readiness skills. Your child will experience new themes, daily activities, and hands-on learning centers. Emphasis will be placed on the alphabet, reading and writing pre-primer sight words, numbers, simple math equations, and creative art. Some of the daily activities such as the calendar and weather will be familiar to your child but will be explored more in depth than in previous years. Come experience a fun filled year full of new and exciting opportunities.

Progress Reports

Your child will receive quarterly progress reports. These will be sent home around fall break, Christmas break, spring break, and at the end of the year.

Class Parties:

At LSA we will celebrate the following holidays: Halloween, Christmas, Valentine's Day, and Easter. Sign-up sheets will be sent home asking for treats. If you wish for your child NOT to participate in these events, please let your child's teacher know in advance.

School Pictures:

Professional school pictures will be taken in the fall and spring. Photo packages are available for purchase. Order forms will be sent home in advance. Payments MUST be paid before pictures are taken.

Arrival/Departure Procedures

Morning Session: Drop off begins at 8:00. Students need to be picked up no later than 11:00.

Afternoon Session: Drop off begins at 11:45. Students need to be picked up no later than 2:45.

IN ORDER FOR PROPER TURN AROUND TIME BETWEEN CLASSES, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES.

All preschool and kindergarten prep classes will enter through our front door. Preschool students will go to the left of the building through the Minds in Motion

room. Kindergarten prep students will go to the right of the building. Please check your child in and out on the IPAD system provided by your child's teacher. Children are dismissed to parents at the end of the program time. Children will only be released to an adult that has been authorized and on our list. When a new adult or care giver will be picking up your child, please send notification of the change to the teacher. Some form of identification will be required the FIRST time a new adult picks up your child.

Discipline Policy:

We believe that discipline should be viewed as an opportunity to teach and guide children.

When a child encounters a problem within the preschool setting, the staff:

1. Will allow the child the opportunity to solve the problem individually
2. Offer suggestions and mediate when necessary
3. Encourage all participants to use words to express feelings
4. Help participants in making a good choice to reach a resolution
5. Move your child to a time-out rug for no longer than one minute per year of your child's age, if necessary.

At no time will any child be physically disciplined or shamed publicly or privately.

If your child's behavior is very disruptive or harmful to himself or other children, we will discuss the issue with your privately. If the situation can be resolved, the child may remain enrolled. If we are unable to resolve the issue, you may be asked to make other child care arrangements.

Communication:

Your child will carry a composition notebook in their backpack. We ask that this go to and from school with them daily. We will use the notebook to communicate back and forth. Please feel free to contact us via phone or email with any questions or concerns.

Personal Item Policy:

Please clearly label all clothing items such a coats and backpacks with your child's name. We also ask that your child please NOT bring any toys or other personal items from home unless instructed by the teacher. We know how special some toys are to children and we do not want anything broken or misplaced accidentally.

School clothing

It is very important for kids to have play time. We will be going outside when the weather permits. Please make sure your child is wearing weather appropriate clothes. To make sure your child is safe when we play outside please make sure your child is also wearing safe shoes.
