On that day, it is also our 3rd grade Mardi Gras Parade. For this occasion, **students can wear a Mardi Gras Shirt**.

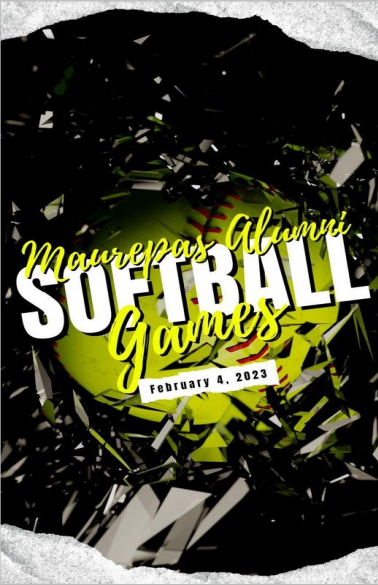
For the FFA Recognition Day on **February 28th**, students can wear a **yellow, or blue shirt** with uniform bottoms.

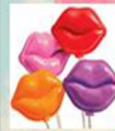

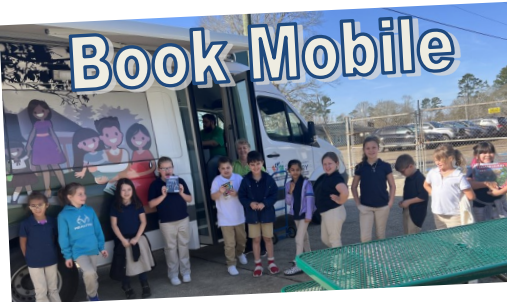
