Contact Information

This section will ensure your potential college, scholarship or employer will know how to contact you. This will include your email and cell phone number!

Career/Job Objective

Having an objective on your resume allows you to summarize your goals, talents and skills. It gives a clear idea of why you are applying to that role and why you would be beneficial to that role!





Education

This section will include: Name of your High School, expected graduation date, GPA (if you have achieved an impressive GPA or completed challenging coursework), and relevant coursework.

Experience

This section will illustrate your work ethic, ability to participate in team activities, leadership qualities and that you are able to balance many things. This section will include: extracurriculars, community service, and employment.





Skills

Highlight responsibilities or transferable skills you can take to this new role to help you stand out. Take time to look at the application and find specific words or requirements that you can align with your skills/talents!

Awards and Honors

Highlight any awards or honors you may have received in high school. This includes awards you may have received with your extracurriculars or academics.
