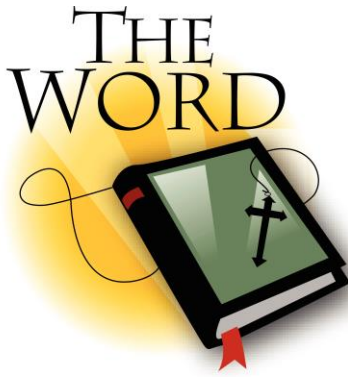

The Dark Side

...We Have an Enemy...

No one wants to be in a battle, but we are in one – whether we know it or not. Ours is a spiritual battle. Anyone with military experience will tell us the value of knowing your enemy and what you're up against. In *The Screwtape Letters*, C. S. Lewis identified two wrong attitudes toward the Devil:

There are two equal and opposite errors into which our race can fall about the devils. One is to disbelieve in their existence. The other is to believe, and to feel an excessive and unhealthy interest in them.

In this study, *The Dark Side*, we see the truth about Satan, demons, and the pervasive paranormal world, but we will also see all we've been given in Christ to stand against these forces. We do not need to be afraid! We will see that, through the truth of who we are in Christ and the armor He has made available to us, we can stand confidently against the Devil's schemes to entrap and enslave. Yes, Satan is mighty, but our God is Almighty!
