Please take careful note of the following club policies:

1. After school clubs end promptly at 4:15 PM. You will need to indicate on the registration form if your child is permitted to walk home, will be sent to SACC following class, or will be picked up at the end of class at the **circle on Jefferson Ave. Children who are picked up late more than once may be asked to leave the class and parents may be assessed a \$15 late fee for up to 15 minutes, or increment thereof, the parent is late for pickup.** If picking up at 4:15 will be a problem for you, please consider signing your child up for SACC on that day. SACC cannot be used without pre-registration.
2. **There will only be clubs on the dates below. Not all days will have after school clubs. In most cases you will not receive notifications when there are no clubs, so please look at the dates and note them on your calendar.** There will be clubs on days where there is a delayed opening. There will **NOT** be clubs on days where there is early or emergency dismissal, holidays, and various other days throughout the year.
5. No student will be admitted to a club without applying through the HSA Enrichment Clubs. Teachers may not agree to admit additional students or change students without the prior approval of the Enrichment Chair (mackayenrichment@gmail.com) and Mrs. Yoo.
6. No student will be allowed to register for a club if the family owes an outstanding balance to the HSA, unless prior arrangements are made with the Co-Presidents (mackayhsacopres@gmail.com) and Mrs Yoo.
7. Please note the school nurse is not on duty during clubs. If your child has allergies, please alert us by sending an email to mackayenrichment@gmail.com so that appropriate precautions are taken.
8. If, in the judgment of the Club Supervisor, after consultation with the club instructor, a student is not working well in a club, his or her club membership will be withdrawn, and you will not receive a refund of the club fee. In addition, that student will not be allowed to register for the same club in a future session.
9. Please note that there are a minimum number of children needed to cover the cost of each club. If a club must be cancelled due to under-enrollment, you will be advised of alternate selections available.
10. The HSA cannot and will not refund club fees for any of the following reasons: if your child is absent from a regular or rescheduled club meeting, if your child drops out of the club after the club fee is paid, or if your child is removed from a club.

11. If there is a cancellation of a club due to inclement weather or Instructor illness, a makeup session will be added at the end of the session. Please be sure to provide appropriate emergency contact numbers so that we can advise you of the need to pick up your child in the event of a cancellation.
