Hosanna to the King! Hosanna to our Lord Jesus! Many of us will be singing and shouting these words of praise and adoration this coming month. Our Holy Week is about to come upon us and there is much to be thankful for and much to give glory to Yeshua.

Many interpret "Hosanna" as a shout of praise or adoration made in recognition of the messiahship of Jesus on his entry into Jerusalem, "Hosanna! 


