Essentia Health relaxing visitor restrictions

As the prevalence of COVID-19 declines across our region, Essentia Health is returning to pre-pandemic patient visitation in our hospitals and clinics.

Like many health systems, Essentia responded to the public health crisis in spring 2020 by limiting visitors to their facilities. This was done to protect patients, staff and the communities they serve. As COVID ebbed and flowed, they adjusted their policy accordingly. This past May, Essentia relaxed it by allowing two adult visitors per patient across all clinic and hospital settings. Those restrictions have been lifted.

This decision was made carefully after evaluating several criteria, including the number of new COVID cases locally and the percent of hospitalized patients. These changes are based on the availability of space in each of their units. Thus, visitors may still be limited in certain units.

Similarly, some restrictions remain in place at their long-term-care facilities. Con-

tact the long-term-care facility you're interested in for the most up-to-date information.

Please note that they will continue to follow guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as state departments of health. Masks are required among everyone within the facilities and they continue to screen all patients and visitors for symptoms of COVID. Additionally, no outside food or beverages will be allowed.

Visitor restrictions remain in place for COVID-positive patients, as well as patients suspected to have COVID. They will continue to apply the prior exceptions related to visitors for patients that require assistance with communication, personal-care issues and in end-of-life situations. These exceptions need to be approved by the team caring for the patient.

SAVE THE DATE: Sept. 11, 2021

Ceremony to mark the 20th Anniversary of 9/11 and Honor Those Who Have Served Since

July 13, 2021 (Saint Paul, Minn.)- The Minnesota Department of Veterans Affairs, the 9/11 and Global War on Terrorism Remembrance Task Force, and the Minnesota Military and Veterans Museum will mark the 20th anniversary of 9/11 with an event on the Minnesota State Capitol grounds this September. The official "9/11 Day of Remembrance" is scheduled in-person for Saturday, Sept. 11, 2021. In addition to memorializing the events of that day and honoring those impacted, this event is focused on honoring the more than 40,000 Minnesota Veterans who have served in the Global War on Terrorism during the last 20 years as well as bringing the community together through a message of hope, unity and resilience.

The event will feature participation in the national Tolling of the Bells, a reading of names of those killed on 9/11/01 and in-action during the Global War on Terrorism, along with a commemorative ceremony including aircraft flyovers, guest speakers, musical performances and military honors. Speakers will include Gov. Tim Walz, retired Army Gen. Joseph Votel, MDVA Commissioner Larry Herke, Gold Star Mother Jill Stephenson and Mariah Jacobson, daughter of Flight 93 hero Tom Burnett.

Other elements of the day will include a documentary screening of Resolute: MN Stories of 9/11 & the War and museum display, Veteran support and discussions groups, live music, food vendors, connection opportunities, children's activities and more.
