

New Vienna City Council Meeting- January 2, 2018

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the meeting at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, and Jim Naber, Mike Leuchs. Absent-Ken Meyer.

The City clerk swore in new council member T.J.Kloser.

Naber made the motion to approve the agenda for January 2, 2018 seconded by Leuchs.

Kloser made the motion to approve the consent agenda, bills, receipts, financial reports, Seconded by Leuchs.

The committee was present to address the council on the Veterans Memorial that they are working on to be placed in New Vienna.; members present were Fred Westhoff, Bob Mc Cabe, and Gerry Westhoff. The memorial will be placed in the new memorial park by City hall. Anyone interested in placing a name on the memorial should contact one of these individuals.

Roger Langel is working on getting an estimate on prices from J&L Lumber as well as other services that we would need. J & L Lumber is working on the plans and estimates, Roger hopes to have some more information at the next meeting.

Mike Neuhaus has talked to our engineer Lucas Elsernd on the water pressure issue for the city; Mike received a quote to do this project from Fehr Graham to present to the council. Mike is going to contact Krapfl Const. and have them look at the quote. The discussion also included the looping of the waterlines by Country Drive.

Resolution #1-2018 Approving Citizens State Bank as the City Depositor was made on a motion from Langel, second by Leuchs. Ayes-all.

Resolution #2-2018 Approving Robert Sudmeier as the City attorney was made on a motion from Langel, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

The Mayor Pat Hermsen appointed Fire Chief Position to Mark Lukan, The Mayor also appointed Roger Langel as Mayor pro tem.

The Council brought up the Police Department and some issues that have come up and would like Chief Blatz present at the next meeting to discuss them. Mayor Pat Hermsen will contact them to be present at the February meeting.

The City has received more complaints from residents on CJ Tire again. Some of the issues are driveways, sidewalks; alleys are constantly blocked with his belongings, a lot of excess material in this area as well. The Council decided that it is time to issue citations and fines. The mayor will stop and talk to Fred.

The council went over the new budget numbers and looked at projects that are up coming.
