February's Meeting Minutes:

Seneschal's Report: Lord Iohannes reports that his quarterly report is on time. Also, the proposed bylaws are attached with the VI and will be voted on in April. The cutoff for Baron/Baroness candidates will be April. There are currently two parties running so far: 1) Lord Eysteinn with Lord Helgulgr and 2) Lord Balthazar.

Chatelaine Report: Lord Eysteinn thanks everyone for sending in the ideas for demons in different locations. He recommends that you continue to do so in order to increase membership in our barony. Shop Nights continue on Friday evenings starting at 5pm - food available.

Exchequer Report: Hilde Steward reports that membership fees for events have increased by \$5 per person and nonmember fees have increased to \$10 starting immediately. Pricing is being changed for our future events. Prereg will be available soon for websites.

Rapier Marshal's Report: Wilhelm von Mansfeld reports that his report was sent in. Gorgets will be available next month. Also there will be a couple of indoor practices in April (April 14th and April 28th).

Archery Captain: Lord Luca reports that his report was sent on time. Practices won't continue until it gets warmer outside unless another marshal would like to hold practices.

Web Minister's Report: Lord Luca reports that the Vi is up on the website. He has read the recent changes that the Board of Directors have sent out. A copy of the login credentials for the website to be given to the Kingdom level for all official SCA websites. Also, it has been requested that one person should not be paying for the website fees and given reimbursement. Instead, it should be paid for directly by the SCA group by check.

Social Media Deputy's Report: THL Birna had nothing to report. Lord Einstein is setting up a meetup (voted on a 1 year setup) and instagram presence for the barony. Hamish mentioned that the local groups are already using the hashtag #ceddarcurtainbaronies. It is recommended that facebook isn't used as much as it is aging out. It is also very difficult for local people to find consistent information as they have to go to several different locations to find all pieces of the information.
