Please be aware of the following revised COVID-19 related guidelines for golf at the Sault Golf Club. All guidelines are subject to change, with safety for staff and guests being our #1 priority.

Tee Time Booking

- > We ask members not to book more than 4 tee times per week.
- > When booking tee times, the booker will only be able to book 1 tee time per day (this is temporary and a change from previous years).

Public Rates

- > Public Green Fee Rates: \$53 Walking, \$66 Riding (no change).
- ** Due to limited Carts, Public green fee players may not have access to carts **
- > Public Twilight Rates: \$35 Walking, \$45 Riding (no change).
- > Public Twilight Times: After 5:30 all week (change).

Safety guidelines

- > Guests are asked to be familiar with all COVID-19 related safety guidelines as per Algoma Public Health (algomapublichealth.com). SGC has installed COVID-19 related signage throughout the course.
- > Please do NOT come to the golf course if you are experiencing any of the identified symptoms.
- > Please follow recommended social distancing measures (6+ feet) for staff and guests at all times.
- > Check in through the ProShop window (or in ProShop if less than 2 people inside). Over the phone payment is encouraged. No Cash.
- > Please do not arrive at the club more than 20 minutes prior to your tee time.
- > Washrooms will be cleaned as per guidelines from authorities. Washroom at #4 tee-off (#15 green) is opened.
- > Driving Range. Please adhere to social distancing – spacing markers will be installed. Limit 1 basket per person. If there is no line up, golfers can get an additional basket.
- > General reminder – Please do NOT touch anything that you do not need to.

Additional Safety Measures:

- > Please do not come to the golf course unless you have a tee-time.
- > Please enter using the east walkway to the ProShop and exit using the west walkway.
- > Please follow instructions from the ProShop staff, ProShop P.A. system or greeter near the first tee.
- > Staff have been educated on the symptoms, risks and revised safety procedures.
- > Tee Times per hour have been adjusted based on best practices (additional 'Starters Times' have been added).
 - Club Storage & push cart storage not offered during the opening week (we will re-assess).
 - Players are encouraged to walk if able. Otherwise, 1 rider per cart (unless from same household).
 - Locker rooms are closed.
 - Sanitizing materials are on site for cart cleaning after each use.

- Hand sanitizers are on site and available for staff and guests.
- Please do not touch the flagstick. Cups will be raised or pool noodles installed – whatever the guidelines dictate.
- Ball washers, garbage cans & trap rakes have not been installed. Please take your garbage with you when you leave (bags available at the Pro Shop).
- Scorecards available through Proshop window upon request.
- Putting green is open with stakes (no holes).
- Lessons. Jeff is offering “contact free” lessons. Large group lessons will be altered.

Food & Beverage

- Mulligans will be available for take-out.
- The Chimney Corner will be closed for the first weekend and will be assessed over the first few weeks.
