Her thoughtful encouragement and consistent presence helped students feel seen and supported. As school counselor she provided the comfortable space many students needed. Whether it was a listening ear, a place to calm down, or a trusted presence nearby, she had a way of meeting students' needs — oftentimes even before they realized they needed support. She was the type of counselor who changed lives for the better, one day at a time.

Vanilla grew up in Camden, attending church at St. Paul Baptist Church and singing in the choir from age two. She graduated from Lincoln High School and started college at Ouachita Baptist University (OBU.) She had previously attended the Upward Bound Program there (1966-1968). While at OBU, Vanilla worked in every position in Upward Bound program, including as a dorm counselor. She is presently a consultant for the TRIO program. This chapter took on memories that left a lifetime impression. She became friends with Brenda Brownlee and the "West End Crew." She even attended Senior Prom at Peake with her Buffalo friends.
