- Reach out to individuals and help them determine their HIV status
- Assist HIV+ clients apply for health insurance and other benefits
- Provide coordinated and high-quality outpatient medical, behavioral and oral health care for patients who are HIV+
- Provide a comprehensive medical and mental health case management service for HIV+ patients
- Help people improve their health status and to help reduce HIV transmission

## WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE FOR HIV+ CLIENTS?

## Neighborhood Health's HIV Team Provides the Following Services

- Outreach and Testing Support to assist clients know their status and get connected to care
- Free Transportation via taxi to and from Neighborhood Health appointments
- Free Interpreters if service in another language is preferred
- Medical Case Management to help patients understand their conditions and to assist with care coordination
- Outpatient Medical Care for HIV care, regular physicals and women's health
- Behavioral Health/Counseling Services for clients needing counseling or support in dealing with HIV+ status or any other activities of daily personal and family life
- Dental Health Care for regular checkups, cleanings, fillings, extractions and dental specialty care
- AIDS Drug Assistance Program to pay for expensive HIV medications
- Lab Services to regularly monitor health condition
- Health Insurance Enrollment for qualified individuals and families and insurance co-payment assistance as needed for most services
