- All Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, and made during the current year.
- "Top Awards" will be given to the top exhibits in Food, Clothing, Home Arts, Handicrafts.
- EXHIBITORS ARE LIMITED TO TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS. (EXCEPT ARTS P-M 835-847 - 1 PER CLASS)
- Not responsible for accidents or breakage.
- All items will be judged in the category in which the exhibitor has placed them. No exceptions.
- Superintendents' and judges' decisions are final.
- All entries will be on display until 7:00 p.m. in the shelter house. Projects are to be picked up between 7–8 p.m. Exhibitors unable to pick up exhibits should make alternate arrangements. Any unclaimed entries will be discarded.
- Premium checks may be picked up at the fair office on Saturday, July 23, after 6:00 p.m. If you can not make it at this time please make other arrangements. If you would like your check mailed to you, you must bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Fair Office the day of your event.


