## **ORDINANCE NO. 18-001**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KANORADO, KANSAS, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF KANORADO IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION, WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 2. Section 11-201 LITTERING. (a) No person shall throw, place, or drop litter from a motor vehicle upon any public street or alley. No person shall throw or deposit any litter upon any public or private property without the consent of the owner of said property. When litter is thrown or placed upon public or private property there shall be a rebuttable presumption that the owner of said property had not consented thereto. Litter shall include but is not necessarily limited to rubbish, garbage, and trash, including tree limbs, yard clippings, paper, metal, plastic, glass, and similar items.

- (b) The City Tree Dump is for the <u>disposal of tree limbs</u>, <u>brush</u>, <u>and leaves ONLY</u>. Use of the site for disposal of TIRES, rubbish, garbage, trash, metal, plastic, glass, lumber and similar items is prohibited. Disposal of prohibited items at the City Tree Dump shall constitute littering. The site is inspected by the State of Kansas to ensure operating compliance with Kansas Open Burning Regulations (K.A.R. 28-19-647).
- (c) Littering is a Class C Misdemeanor and may be punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00 and/or 30 days in jail.

**Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the governing body of the City, and publication in the official City newspaper.
