The DCSAC consists of community volunteers dedicated to supporting the Sheriff's Office by obtaining grants and private donations for needed equipment and education not afforded in the general budget.

It is impossible to put a dollar value on increased safety for Douglas County citizens and Douglas County Sheriff's deputies. Nor is there a way to assign a quantitative value to increased peace of mind. The items purchased for the Sheriff's Office have added to an overall state of safety that would otherwise not have been possible through the Office's budget.



Peace Of Mind

The DCSAC supports the community anti-drug program, "DRUG USE IS LIFE ABUSE" (DUILA). DUILA signs are displayed in local businesses and the DUILA bumper stickers on vehicles. DUILA also provides drug and alcohol abuse education programs and materials to Douglas County schools. You can also order drug and alcohol screening kits on the website. These kits are an excellent tool for confidential drug and alcohol detection.
