To Be Worn For Arrival

- T146 Class B T-Shirt
- Swimsuit
- Socks
- Shoes or Boots
- T146 Cap

Clothes

- Class A Uniform (full uniform)
- 4+ T-Shirts
- 4+ Shorts
- 1+ Long Sleeve Shirt
- 1+ Long Pants
- 4+ Underwear
- 4+ Pair of Socks
- Hiking Boots
- Water shoes / Sandals for shower

Sleeping Gear

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Mosquito Net
- Mosquito Net Polls
- Bungee cords or duck tape or zip tights

Toilet Kit

- Soap
- Toothbrush & paste
- 2 Kleenex packets for toilet tissue
- Sunscreen
- ChapStick or Blistex
- Insect Repellent
- Large Ziplock bag for trash or dirty clothes

Packing General Guidelines

-) NO ELECTRONICS! We hike and camp to enjoy nature and learn about the outdoors. We promise that you'll survive a couple days without a cell phone, iPod, etc.! If you need to get in touch with your parents, adults will have cell phones and the camp office has a couple of phones.

Essentials

- 1 Compass
- 2 Pocket Knife / Leatherman
- 3 LED Flashlight or Headlamp (+bulb & battery)
- 4 Sun glasses (req'd above 9000')
- 5 Matches in waterproof case
- 6 Personal First Aid kit
- 7 Canteen / Water Bottle / Camelback
- 8 Light, Waterproof Jacket
- 9 BSA Handbook
- 10 Towel

Additional Items

- Whistle
- Journal / Pad of Paper
- Pencil
- Deck of Cards
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- Frisbee or ball
- A small amount of cash for the trading post

NOTES

Gear should be packed in a trunk or lockable storage that can slide under a cot. We expect all scouts to be honest and respectful of others (and their belongings).

Class A uniforms are worn every morning for muster and breakfast and every evening for muster and dinner.

-) All items should be secured in or on your pack. Dangling items will get lost in transit!
-) Don't bring food! The wildlife (including bears) would love to visit your little stash of candy bars. Don't give them a reason to come into camp and get into your stuff.
