
Please mark your calendars for these events and if possible come out to support our breed and these Clubs.






# 2016 AKC Agility Invitational

# Health Committee

### PPPA Health and Research Committee Report to the Club January 31, 2017

#### **OFA Reports**

OFA has released the Reports through December 31, 2016. Our breed is ranked #173 on the HIPS chart and #15 on the Patellar Luxation chart. There was only 1 "ineligible" HIP this year and our Patellar Luxation percentage remains at about 7% with the majority being Grade 1.

The OFA EYE reports are based only on those eye tests which have been sent to them for publishing. The more accurate view of eye tests are contained in the Blue Book published by the ACVO. When we have our eyes tested at shows or on other occasions, they must be done by an ACVO diplomat who automatically sends in one of the copies and so the Blue Book has every eye test accounted for statically without revealing the name of the dog.

OFA sent the 2015 Blue Book which shows 99 dogs were examined with 81 having Normal Globes for an 81.8% Normal rating. This number is fairly consistent with the findings from Finland. I have attached the three pages of PPP information from the 2015 Blue Book as "Attachment A". You can look at the entire Blue Book for 2015 here:

If you have any questions please let me know.

Remember that compliance with performing the three recommended tests in the Code of Ethics will list your dog in the CHIC registry. Those tests are HIPS, Patellar Luxation, and CAER EYE examinations. The only one that is required to be conducted every year is the EYE exam and should be performed within one year of breeding. CERF numbers can be verified at <a href="http://www.caninehealthinfo.org/search.html">http://www.caninehealthinfo.org/search.html</a> and clicking on the dog's name will take you directly to its record on the OFA site. If the EYE test is still valid the CHIC logo after the dog's name will be a maroon color and if not it will be gray.

#### **DNA Testing for PRA**

There has now been a fourth carrier of "crd4 PRA" (formally "cord1-PRA") identified in Sweden. This dog is of the same family as the three we reported earlier. Again, anyone who tested with Optimal Selection has been checked for this disease. Please see the Ocular Disorders page.

There now is a second form of PRA which was identified in mid-November when two dogs in Finland tested "AFFECTED" for "prcd PRA". They had been diagnosed by examination then verified by the DNA testing. As of this writing four more "CARRIERS" were located with one in Finland, one in Sweden, and two in Norway. There are additional tests now being run on dogs in Norway, Sweden, Finland, and Germany.

The "prcd PRA" was not available for testing under the Optimal Selection test but will be available as an added test soon.

Remember that as breeders we now have DNA testing for these two types of PRA which allows us to keep them from showing up in the future.

#### **Description and Comments**

A. Distichiasis

Eyelashes abnormally located on the eyelid margin which may cause ocular irritation. Distichiasis may occur at any time in the life of a dog. It is difficult to make a strong recommendation with regard to breeding dogs with this entity. The hereditary basis has not been established although it seems probable due to the high incidence in some breeds. Reducing the incidence is a logical goal. When diagnosed, distichiasis should be recorded; breeding discretion is advised.

B. Persistent pupillary membranes (PPM)

Persistent blood vessel remnants in the anterior chamber of the eye which fail to regress normally by 3 months of age. These strands may bridge from iris to iris, iris to cornea, iris to lens, or form sheets of tissue in the anterior chamber. The last three forms pose the greatest threat to vision and when severe, vision impairment or blindness may occur.

C. Vitreous degeneration

A liquefaction of the vitreous gel which may predispose to retinal detachment.

There are no references providing detailed descriptions of hereditary ocular conditions of the Portuguese Podengo Pequeno breed. The conditions listed above are generally recognized to exist in this breed, as evidenced by identification on breed eye screening examinations and/or clinical experience of veterinary ophthalmologists.
