



## NEW ELECTRIC MOBILITY OPTIONS

On May 17 a demonstration of several new mobility options – electric bikes, electric scooters, e-cruisers, and on-demand electric vans – was held in the parking lot of the Eastpoint Shopping Center and at City Dock. The electric bikes and scooters are available through the Bird app, and the on-demand electric vans are available through the Go Annapolis app (see info on downloading each app below). The e-cruiser is a vehicle currently in use in downtown Annapolis and may be used in the future in Eastport.

The Bird e-bikes and scooters are available at various “parking lots” around Annapolis (and to where it must be left in order to end the charge to the user’s account). The Bird app has a map to show the locations and current bike and/or scooter availability each location.

The Annapolis Go on-demand e-van can pick-up and drop-off in a defined area within the Annapolis city boundaries, and rides are \$2 a trip, with an extra \$1 charge for each additional rider in your group (the first two rides are free using the code “GO4FREE!”). The Go Annapolis app has a map to show the current ride boundaries in which the e-van operates.
