COVID-19 Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home -

All residents continue to be on precautionary isolation until November 6th. This is out of an abundance of caution and is consistent with CDC & NYSDOH guidance for nursing home residents. This was confirmed on Sunday when we conferred with NYSDOH.

All resident testing for COVID-19 is negative. As of this time, no residents are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. Weekly testing of both staff and residents continues.

Unfortunately, this means visitation is on pause through this precautionary quarantine period as residents on isolation for any reason are not permitted visitors per NYSDOH guidance.

Virtual visits are available daily. Please contact Social Services or Recreation to set this up. All medical appointments outside the facility except dialysis or other medically emergent visits continue to be curtailed as well as out on pass.

COVID has not gone away. Local communities are still seeing higher than average rates.
