Minutes of September 4, 2018

The Huntington Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 PM at the Township Hall. Meeting called to order with the pledge of Allegiance by Robert Holmes. Also present were Jed Lamb, Walter Rollin, Dimitri Szynal, Dennis Finkel, Frances Rollin and Sheila Lanning.

Motion by Rollin with a second by Lamb to approve the minutes of the August 6, 2018 regular scheduled meeting as written. Roll call: 3 yeas. Charges and checks (8371-8394) totaling \$24,386.15 were approved for payment. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve August financial reports with year to date revenue of \$343,057.19 expenditures of \$212,224.12 and bank balance of \$386,505.91. Roll call: 3 yeas.

Holmes reported: Public records request sent per Lanning. Salt prices are \$71.64 a ton, discussion on why higher prices. Lanning to send information to Rochester about the pricing, contracted to buy 100 ton. Reminder to employees working in the heat to be safe and drink water. No calculation on final cost of this year's blacktop, work in other Townships about to finish with approximately three loads left in Rochester. The ends of the roads are going to be completed by Bergman but Finkel not sure on the timing. Bergman will be back, left 150 ton of stone here that may be intended for the ends of the roads. Broke a belt on mower when cutting roadsides. Holmes understood the paperwork for the Griggs Road project is signed, hope to see work on the flooding issues start soon. Asked Dimitri about the shape of the Cemeteries: barely keeping up, will call John Pipcak if needed. No further word from EPA on the Landfill, Lanning sent the first quarter of 2018 reports to EPA's Katarina and LC Health District. Received an email regarding firearm discharge in the Township, called to talk to LC Prosecutor Jerry Innes but he is out of town. Will follow up with him on the meetings they have had previously with other Townships. August Sheriff report shows 24 incidents. Land Use Plan needs updated; the 2012 update was never adopted. Rollin to ask people to donate time on the update committee. Water hydrant on corner of Griggs and Rte. 58 repaired. Ice cream social went well. The Historical road tour is September 23. SWAC meeting Thursday, the 2019 storm water applications are available. Finkel given the application, which is due 12/16/2018. The ceremony to dedicate four Revolutionary War Graves was set for September 23. Lanning to check with Gil Sanow about the firm date and time. Put the following on Facebook: LC Public Health blood tests, Vaccine clinics, Collection Center and Agricultural Tire Collection, LC Soil and Water Conservation District newsletter, Island Road Closure, LC free Clinic 10/5/2018. There is a NOACA workshop 9/13/2018. Northeast Ohio litter summit is 9/7/2018. Three property transfers in Huntington Township. LC Solid waste grant awards in paper, Lanning stated our paperwork not yet ready to turn in for grant. Hoarding task force meeting upcoming and discussion on getting money from SWAC for logiam on creek on Baker Road.

Lamb reported: LORCO activity report received. Fair went well with Wednesday being a hit on kids day. Watering the parking lot discussed possibility to use calcium chloride for dust. Will be unable to make the 9/13 meeting, Holmes to see if possible for him to attend.

Rollin reported: Board minutes received, meeting coming up tomorrow. Received call on trash on corner of Rte. 58 and New London Eastern Road. Township water meter broke and repaired after being hit by mowing crew.

Fiscal Officer reported: Received second half real property tax and rollbacks in August. Insurance renewal paperwork received copies to Finkel, Lamb, and Holmes to review property values. Need

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the Engineer sign off on Baker Road Storm Water Grant to apply for reimbursement. Trash bags needed for Township Hall, any other supplies needed before ordering. Open and Close for Mary McMahon not received, family contacted Finkel to discuss date and time. Signatures for two deeds: Michael Moskal and Sean Wallace (Timothy Sexton).

Road Foreman reported: Talked to ODOT about the Jake Brake signs, they will get back to us.

Public comments: Dumpster days are October 19th and 20th 9:00-3:00. Dimitri asked about the Cemetery Grant that was mentioned previously, Lamb suggested calling Dick Stein.
