DISCUSSION	Four counties are currently enrolled in the 24/7 program. Natrona, Campbell, Sweetwater and Fremont. Participants in the program and statistics were provided to the group. Numbers continue to grow monthly at about 5000 breath tests per month statewide. Laramie and Sheridan County are potentially joining the program. Mike provided an update as to the contract with Intoximeter and changes that will lower the cost to the counties up to 60,000 tests per year. Alternative testing devices are being researched for addition to the rules promulgated by the Attorney General’s Office.
