

# Golden Fleece Goldenrod



This perennial makes a great addition to any garden. It grows in just about any soil type and has a short stature. Goldenrods have a very high wildlife value. They are an important food source for countless pollinators including the migrating Monarchs. Solidago species are a larval host for 115 species of butterflies and moths. Golden Fleece is drought tolerant and deer don't normally eat it.

- Hardiness: Zone 4-9
- Size: 1-2'
- Flower: Yellow flowers from August to October
- Culture: Prefers full sun and well-drained soils. Drought-tolerant.
- Uses: Border, groundcover, naturalizing, rock garden, meadow, pollinators, butterflies, birds, deer and drought tolerant, semi-evergreen, container, medicinal, cut flower
