





#### MARDI GRAS SLOW COOKER LOUISIANA RED BEANS AND RICE

Always a popular dish the day of, and the day after!

#### **Ingredients**

4 - 16 oz. cans kidney beans, rinsed and drained

1 - 14 1/2 oz. can diced tomatoes with juice

1 - 14 oz. smoked turkey sausage, sliced

3 celery ribs, chopped

1 large onion, chopped

1 C. chicken broth

1 medium green pepper, chopped

1 small sweet red pepper, chopped

6 garlic cloves, minced

1 bay leaf

1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes

2 green onions, chopped

Hot cooked rice

#### **Instructions**

In a 4 or 5 qt. slow cooker, combine all ingredients except rice and green onions. Cook, covered, on low until vegetables are tender, 3-4 hours. Stir before serving. Remove bay leaf. Serve over rice with green onions on top.



## IRISH BAILEYS AND WHISKEY COCKTAIL

Try this for your St. Patrick's Day celebration!

#### **Ingredients**

1 oz. Jameson Irish whiskey 1/2 oz. peach schnapps 1/2 oz. Baileys Irish Cream 2 oz. orange juice Half an orange slice Maraschino cherry

#### **Instructions**

Pour all ingredients into a shaker glass and shake. Strain into a chilled martini glass.

Garnish with an orange fruit flag (half an orange slice with a cherry in the middle, held together with a skewer).



#### ST. PATRICK'S DAY GUACAMOLE

This is deliciously different with an Irish twist.

#### **Ingredients**

3 avocados

Juice from 1/2 a lemon

Salt and fresh ground black pepper, to taste

1/2 c. carrots, very finely diced

1/4 c. red onions, very finely diced

1/4 c. jalapeño, very finely diced (optional)

1 clove garlic, crushed

3 slices cooked bacon, chopped

1/4 c. parsley, very finely chopped

2 oz. Irish cheddar cheese, crumbled

#### **Instructions**

In large bowl, mash avocados with lemon juice, salt and pepper.

Stir in carrots, onion, jalapeño, garlic, bacon, parsley and

cheese.

For a beautiful presentation, reserve a small portion of the mix-ins for garnish. Serve with fresh veggies, tortilla chips, Fritos scoops, and/or kettle cooked potato chips.
