

Ordinance No 39

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF
HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW
MUNICH, INCORPORATING PROVISIONS OF
THE STATE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION
ACT BY REFERENCE, AND IMPOSING A
PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Council of the Village of New Munich, Stearns County, Minnesota,
ordains:

Section 1. Highway Traffic Regulation Act Incorporated by Reference.

The regulatory provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 169, as amended by Laws of Minnesota 1967, are hereby adopted as the Traffic Ordinance regulating the use of highways, streets and alleys within the Village of New Munich and are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as completely as if set out in full.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person or persons violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment for a period of not to exceed 90 days; but if a minimum fine or imprisonment is prescribed by the State Highway Traffic Act for any such offense, such penalty shall apply to a person convicted of the same offense under this ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective from its passage and publication.
