A Read-to-Me Bible Story from Acts 3:1-12, 16 Every day a man who had never

been able to walk was carried to a gate of the temple-church in lerusalem. The man would ask people for money.



Find some friends and do the march above. One person can be the leader who gives commands, while the others follow and echo the commands.




Trace over the broken lines to complete the foot. Color the foot. Thank God for people who use their feet and legs to go tell others about Jesus.
