## PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

### Parking Options

- We are proud to provide FREE parking to all our patients.
- Please follow the directions below to park in our free parking garage.
- Please, park in designated spaces so as to avoid getting towed.
- For metered street parking bring quarters.

### Accommodations for Patients with Disabilities:

- The garage parking has wheelchair access for your convenience.
- The garage has designated spots for patients with disability placards.
- There are also street parking options for patients with disability placards.
- A wheelchair lift is also available for street parking if needed. If you plan on using the lift notify us ahead of time so that we can assist you in its use. The lift is accessible through South Los Robles Ave.

### How to Get to the Office:

#### **If you are Headed South on S. Los Robles Ave:**

Headed south on Los Robles Ave, once you pass Green Street, the entrance to our parking garage is located in the center of the brown and cream colored building. The driveway is right after the street narrows from a two lanes to one lane and right before the "Art of Smiles" dentist office sign. If you pay attention to the fire hydrants on the street and you are headed south on South Los Robles Ave, you can pull into the parking garage drive-way before the second fire hydrant once you pass Green Street.

#### **If you are Headed North on S. Los Robles Ave:**

Headed north on Los Robles Ave, the entrance to our parking garage is located directly across El Dorado Street, once you pass the historical "Hotel Livingstone" brick building. The driveway to the garage is located right north of the "Art of Smiles" dentist office and slightly north of the fire-hydrant on the west side of the street. The garage entrance is through the burgundy and cream colored building.



### How to Access Garage through Gate:

Once you pull into the driveway for the parking garage, there is a buzzer located on the wall on the right side clearly marked with the doctor's name. As the buzzer is located on the passenger side, you need to exit your vehicle to press the button. This will alert our staff of your arrival so that we can remotely open the metal gate for you to enter the garage.

### Where to Park once Inside the Garage:

Once inside the parking garage, drive straight ahead towards the far wall directly across the entrance. The driveway slopes down a bit and leads you to our 5 free parking spots marked with green and white parking signs with the doctor's name on it. If these are inaccessible there are also parking spots for patients with disability placards immediately to your left upon entering the garage. Please, drive carefully as the garage drive-way is a two-way path. If you enter the garage with the gate open, please call our office so we can assist you or read below for alternative exit to the street to use our main door.

### How to Enter the Office from the Garage:

- Once parked, the entrance to the hall way which leads to the office is located on the left hand side marked with a sign for the office. One of our staff members will come greet you at the door as the door requires a pin to open.
- Alternative entrance would be to walk towards the main metal gate you entered from and exit the building towards the left side of the gate through the double doors which lead into the street. Walk south a bit to the historical "Hotel Livingstone" brick building and enter the office using the stairs located underneath the large street sign for the office
